

Germany's International Climate Finance 2005-2015 (in EUR millions)*









Overview of Portfolio and Priority Funding Areas

- Development / implementation of (I)NDCs, NAMAs, LCDS / Green Economy, MRV systems / transparency, finance
- Renewable energies, energy efficiency, transport, resource efficiency, urban development



Mitigation

- Development / implementation of NAPs / NAPAs
- Ecosystem-based adaptation (EbA)
- Management of climate risk, e.g. insurance



Adaptation

- REDD+ business models and results-based finance
- REDD+ strategies and governance, data systems and safeguards
- Restoration of forest landscapes


- Implementation of Strategic Plan 2011-2020:






Level of IKI support according to region (2008-2016, in € million)*


