


Why transport matters for climate?

- **No “2 degree target” without “Verkehrswende”!**
 - Transport causes ¼ of the global GHG-emissions
 - Sector with the fastest growing GHG-Emissions (!):
2050 pathways: today 7,5Gt - BAU 14 Gt - needed 2,5 Gt
- **Cooperation with emerging and developing countries relevant!**
 - GHG-emission trends (2010-2030, IEA):
+80-365%, depending on region, globally +60%
 - Additional investments required (USD 150 billion p.a.). But:
 - » too short pipeline of bankable investments
 - » insufficient institutional and human capacities to handle investments
 - » Missing interfaces for donors, particularly related to climate finance („NDC Support Channels“)

IKI TRANSfer: a global approach

- **Target outcome:**
Emerging and developing countries increase their engagement for sustainable, climate-friendly transport through international support
(Duration (3 Phasen): 10/2010-12/2020); Volume: EUR 16 M + EU 6M)



MobiliseYourCity: Objectives and Goals

MobiliseYourCity focusses on Sustainable Urban Mobility Planning.

It supports cities and national governments in emerging and developing countries to plan sustainable urban mobility.



MobiliseYourCity is a global partnership launched at COP21. It is an international transport initiative under the **UNFCCC action agenda (MP-GCA)**. It assists beneficiaries in achieving their National Determined Contributions (NDCs).



MobiliseYourCity contributes to the New Urban Agenda and UN's 2030 Agenda, specifically Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 11: Make cities inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable.



Quantitative goals:

- **≥ 100 cities** acknowledged MobiliseYourCity and the need to implement *Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans (SUMPs)* targeting >50% CO2 until 2050
 - **≥ 20 national governments** acknowledged MobiliseYourCity and the need to implement **National Urban Mobility Policies & Investment Programs (NUMPs)**









Service Lines
