BACKGROUND


- Aim of New Urban Agenda: “**No one should be left behind**”

- What is the way/system of living humans desire for? - In order to address the gap.




An ecovillage/community is most frequently defined in the following way: a human-scale settlement that is intended to be full-featured — providing food, manufacturing, leisure, social opportunities, and commerce — the goal of which is the harmless integration of human activities into the environment in a way that supports healthy human development in physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual ways, and is able to continue into the indefinite future (Bang 2005, 27).
